



THE WOODLEIGH PAWDATE 2026 TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The Woodleigh Pawdate 2026 (“**Programme**”) is organised by The Woodleigh Mall Pte Ltd (“**Organiser**”). By participating in the Programme, you agree to accept and be bound by the terms and conditions set out herein and any other terms and conditions applicable to the Programme (including without limitation any specific terms and conditions applicable to any specific activities), and the terms and conditions of the S³ Rewards Programme (collectively, the “**T&Cs**”).

The T&Cs may be amended by the Organiser at any time by posting the amended terms and conditions at The Woodleigh Mall Website at <https://www.thewoodleighmall.com/> without prior notice. Any continued participation in the Programme after the amendment of the T&Cs shall be deemed to be acceptance of the amended terms and conditions by the Participant. If the Participant does not agree to the amended terms and conditions, the Participant shall have the right to terminate his/her participation in accordance with the T&Cs.

1. Agreement

- i. You hereby represent and warrant that you are at least 18 years old and have the necessary legal capacity, right, power and authority to agree to the T&Cs.
- ii. Parents/guardians must provide consent for their child/ward who is less than 18 years old to participate in the Programme. If you are contracting as parent or guardian of a child or ward who is less than 18 years old and who is registering for and/or participating in the Programme, you agree as his/her parent/guardian, both in your personal capacity and on behalf of your child/ward, to be bound by the T&Cs, and to be liable for your child’s or ward’s acts, omissions and/or breaches of the T&Cs while registering and/or participating in the Programme, and you also agree to ensure that your child or ward observes the T&Cs.

2. Eligibility

- i. To be eligible to participate in the Programme, the Participant must possess an entry pass. Children below 4 years old, based on birth year, can enter the Programme for free.

3. Programme

- i. The Programme will be held at the following locations, or such other location within the premises (which shall be determined at the Organiser’s sole and absolute discretion) of The Woodleigh Mall.
 - a. Aviary zone – L1 Event Space near Entrance facing Upper Serangoon Road
 - b. Cat zone – L1 Atrium
 - c. Dog zone – L1 Event Space outside Bidadari Community Club
- ii. The Programme will take place on 18 and 19 July 2026 (the “**Programme Period**”), from 11am to 6pm.

4. Registration via Eventbrite and Donations

- i. A registration fee of \$5.00 is payable for each Participant. Each ticket admits 1 person and entitles the Participant to receive a goodie pack containing \$15 Tenant eVoucher (*\$10 Surrey Hills Grocer eVoucher and \$5 Cow Play Cow Moo eVoucher*) and a Bingo Card. Children under 4 years old, based on birth year, do not require a ticket and will not receive the goodie pack.
- ii. All payment must be made in full via [Eventbrite website](#).
- iii. Tickets purchased through Eventbrite are subject to Eventbrite's applicable ticketing fees, which comprise:
 - a. Service fee of 2.5% of the ticket price + S\$0.99 per sold ticket; and
 - b. Payment processing fee of 2% of the total order value.

- iv. Nett proceeds received by the Organiser after deduction of applicable Eventbrite ticketing fees and payment processing fees will be donated to designated animal welfare group(s) (at the Organiser's sole and absolute discretion).
- v. Participants will receive an order confirmation email upon successful payment and registration.

5. Registration via S³ Rewards

- i. S³ Rewards members may also redeem one ticket using 800 S³ Rewards points, subject to availability.
- ii. S³ Rewards members who successfully register for the Programme will receive an eVoucher that will indicate the date of visit for the programme via the S³ Rewards mobile application.

6. Admission

- i. Registration opens 10 minutes before each Programme at #01-49 (near Starbucks).
- ii. On the day of the Programme, Participants must present valid proof of registration for admission:
 - a. Eventbrite registrants must present their confirmation email with valid Order Number (screenshots will not be accepted); and
 - b. S³ Rewards members must present their eVoucher via the S³ Rewards mobile application (screenshots will not be accepted).
- iii. Upon registration, each Participant will be issued a coloured wristband. Participants may re-enter the Programme on the same day upon presentation of a valid wristband. The Organiser reserves the right to refuse re-entry to Participants who are unable to present their wristband for verification.
- iv. If at any point during the Programme, the Organiser believes that a Participant is causing a disruption to the Programme, the Organiser reserves the right, exercisable at its sole and absolute discretion, to ask the Participant to leave.
- v. The Organiser reserves the right to change the Programme Period at any time in its sole and absolute discretion without prior notice and without liability to any party.

7. Health & Safety

- i. For the safety and well-being of all pets and attendees, Participants are strongly encouraged to ensure that their pets are in good health and up to date with the recommended vaccinations before attending the Programme.

- iii. Participants must not leave their pets unattended at any time during the Programme.
- iv. Participants are responsible for cleaning up after their pets and must dispose of pet waste in an appropriate and sanitary manner.
- v. Children attending the Programme must be supervised by a parent or legal guardian at all times, especially when interacting with animals.
- vi. Pets need to be placed in pet carriers/strollers or carried at all times while in the indoor premises of The Woodleigh Mall.
- vii. Owners of dog breeds specified in the First Schedule of the Animals and Birds (Licensing and Control of Cats and Dogs) Rules 2024, or any other applicable legislation, must ensure that their dogs are properly muzzled in public and always comply with all statutory requirements during the Programme.
- viii. Participants and their pets attend and participate in the Programme at their own risk. The Organiser shall not be liable for any injury, illness, loss, damage, theft, or accident suffered

- by any Participant, pet, or personal property arising from or in connection with the Programme, except where such liability cannot be excluded by law.
- ix. The Organiser reserves the right to refuse entry to, or require the removal of, any Participant or pet if, in its sole and absolute discretion, it considers that the health, safety, welfare, or comfort of any person or animal may be compromised.
 - x. Participants may be denied entry, or required to leave the Programme, if their pet appears to be unwell, injured, aggressive, distressed, or suffering from any contagious illness or condition that may pose a risk to other Participants or animals.

8. Rescheduling or Cancellations

- i. No rescheduling, cancellation, or refund will be provided.

9. Disclaimers

- i. Personal belongings are brought to the Participant's risk, and the Organiser does not accept liability for any loss or damage whatsoever to such items.
- ii. The Organiser makes no warranty or representation of any kind, including without limitation any warranty as to the quality, merchantability, or fitness for a particular purpose, in respect of any participating merchants' goods and services. Any dispute about the same must be resolved directly between the Participant and the participating merchants.
- iii. The Organiser shall not be liable for any loss (including, without limitation, direct, indirect, special, incidental, consequential or punitive loss), damage, personal injury or death howsoever caused arising directly or indirectly out of or in connection with the Programme, the T&Cs (or any of the matters contemplated therein), any goods and services of the participating merchants and/or any gift/prize redeemed or awarded in connection with the Programme, whether for breach of contract, tort or other cause of action, save for any liability that cannot be excluded by law (in which case that liability is limited to the minimum allowable by law).
- iv. By participating in the Programme, Participants agree and undertake to, at all times, fully indemnify and hold the Organiser, Straits Retail Property Management Services Pte Ltd ("**SRPMS**"), their respective employees and affiliates harmless from and against any and all losses, damages, actions, demands, injuries, claims, costs (including legal costs on a full indemnity basis), expenses, fines and penalties, howsoever caused arising directly or indirectly out of or in connection with the Programme, and/or any breach or purported breach of the T&Cs and/or any applicable law.
- v. Photographs and videos of you may be taken during the Programme. Such photographs and videos may be stored by the Organiser and the authorised representatives, and may be used on various social media sites, websites, corporate publications, and other media. Participant participation at the Programme signifies your consent to the foregoing.
- vi. In the event of any inconsistencies between these terms and conditions and any brochure or marketing, promotional or other materials relating to the Programme, the Organiser's final decision on such terms and conditions shall prevail.
- vii. The Organiser reserves the right to suspend, cancel or terminate the Programme and/or remove or vary any of the privileges or entitlements under or in relation to the Programme, at any time, in its sole and absolute discretion without prior notice and without liability to any party.
- viii. The Organiser reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to transfer and/or assign all rights and obligations under the Programme and the T&Cs to another entity pursuant to any restructuring, merger or sale, or for any reason whatsoever, without prior

notice and without liability to any party. In such an event, the entity which is assigned all such rights and obligations under the Programme and the T&Cs shall be responsible for fulfilling all obligations under these T&Cs (whether arising on or prior to the date on which such obligations are transferred and/or assigned) as if it had been named in the T&Cs in place of the Organiser.

- ix. Additional terms and conditions may apply to the Programme.

10. Personal Data Protection Act Provisions

- i. By participating in the Programme, Participants hereby agree and consent to the terms of the privacy policy (which can be found at [<https://www.cuscadenpeak.com/privacy-policy>]) ("**Privacy Policy**") as amended from time to time, and the terms of the Privacy Policy are incorporated into these T&Cs by reference.
- ii. Participants are required to give current, accurate, truthful, and complete personal data as requested. Data given is the responsibility of the Participant. If in connection with Participants' participation in the Programme, Participants provide the personal data of any third parties, Participants further warrant and represent that these third parties have also consented to the terms of the Privacy Policy, and to the collection, use and disclosure of their personal data in accordance with the aforesaid.
- iii. SRPMS may suspend or terminate the Participant's participation in the Programme if the data given is not correct or is incomplete, without prior notice.
- iv. SRPMS and/or its related entities, affiliates, and subsidiaries (collectively referred to herein as "**Straits Properties**") and/or their respective agents, business partners and service providers (who may be based outside Singapore) collecting, using, disclosing and processing the Participants' personal data, and sharing the Participants' personal data between themselves for the purposes of administering the Programme, and for the following purposes:
- Identity verification;
 - Administering and managing the Programme;
 - Responding to Participants' queries and feedback;
 - Sending promotional information;
 - Profiling and statistical analysis to improve services provided to Participants; and
 - Market research.
- v. While SRPMS will take reasonable steps to accurately record personal data, Participants shall also provide accurate and complete personal data and keep them updated at all times.
- vi. Participants must contact the Data Protection Officer of SRPMS at dpo@cuscaden.com.sg if they wish to withdraw their consent on the use of their personal data; have any questions or complaints in relation to their personal data; or wish to obtain access and make corrections to their personal data.
- vii. SRPMS may not be able to continue allowing participation in the Programme when a Participant withdraws consent to any or all use of his/her personal data.
- viii. Participants agree that their consents granted for the Programme supplement but do not supersede nor replace any other consent previously granted to any entity in Straits Properties. Withdrawal of consents also does not affect any other consents granted to any entity in Straits Properties.
- ix. SRPMS may share aggregated and anonymized information with third parties, such as retailers, business and marketing partners for use in marketing, promotional and other activities.
